

Cork City FC – Girls Technical Academy - TERMS & CONDITIONS:

The Cork City FC Girls Technical Academy is open to girls between the ages of 7 & 16.

Insurance:

All Girls Technical Academy sessions will be covered by Public Liability Insurance only.

Fees & Discounts:

Once the fees have been received, confirmation will be issued by email. The confirmation email is receipt of your place on the academy and payment received.

Medical Assistance:

All medical information must be provided in advance of the Girls Technical commencing. By signing up to the programme you give your permission to allow your child to be given medical treatment either by way of first aid by a suitably qualified person or by a doctor. You also consent to your child being taken to a doctor or hospital in case of emergency. If there is any change to the medical information you provided on your application form you must inform us prior to the Girls Technical Academy commencing.

Damages/Injuries/Loss of Possessions:

The Girls Technical Academy will operate to the highest standards, but Cork City FC will not be held responsible for damages, injuries, or loss of possessions. We strongly recommend that no valuables are brought to the academy.

Conduct:

Participants must follow the instructions of the coaching staff in charge. Misbehaviour or bullying may result in the participant being expelled from the Girls Technical Academy and any fees will not be refunded. In the interest of safety, participants are not permitted to leave the Girls Technical Academy during the session times without the written consent of a parent/guardian. If a child is expelled from the Girls Technical Academy their parent/guardian will be contacted immediately to collect the child.

Clothing:

All participants must wear CCFC Girls Technical Academy training wear when received. Gear may take 4-6 weeks from sign up to the academy.

Data Policy:

Retention of Data Policy Cork City Football Club will retain your entered data in relation to this camp sign up and contact you in future about potential camps. Please email info@corkcityfc.ie if you would no longer like to be contacted.

Photographic or Video Permission:

Sign up for Girls Technical Academy is under the agreement that you allow Cork City FC to take photos/videos of your child involved in the camp for use in future promotional material for the academy and social media updates throughout the camp. These may be published on Cork City FC's website, social media pages or match-day magazine.

Weather: In cases where the weather has affected the condition of the playing surface or is deemed so bad that coaching activities must be suspended, the academy coordinator will contact the parent or guardian to advise them of the suspension of coaching activities. It will then be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to make arrangements to collect their child immediately. The coaching staff will supervise all children until they have been collected.

Refunds:

In the unlikely event that inclement weather or COVID-19 restrictions force the cancellation of the academy activities a full refund will be issued. If inclement weather or COVID-19 restrictions cause only partial cancellation of the academy, no refund will be issued. Cork City FC reserve the right to make date/time/venue changes if necessary.
